Jean Fanor is a native of Haiti but prepped at North Miami Senior High and earned All-Dade Honorable Mention as a receiver and defensive back. He signed with the Kansas City Chiefs as an undrafted rookie free agent and spent the 2012 NFL training camp competing for a spot.

Fanor, who is in his second season with the Storm, leads the team and set the single season record in tackles with 119 and 103 of them being solo which is also the most in the league. He has attained 12 pass breakups, two interceptions, two forced fumbles, and one fumble recovery while scoring one touchdown.
